CLEANING AWARENESS CAMPAIGN UNDER KHALORE G.P

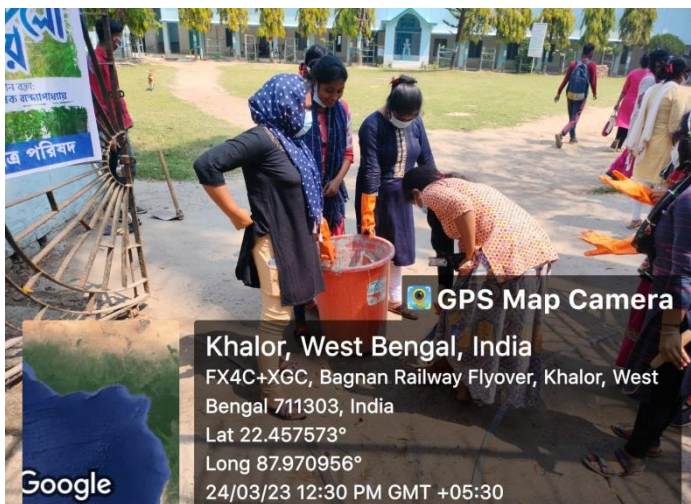
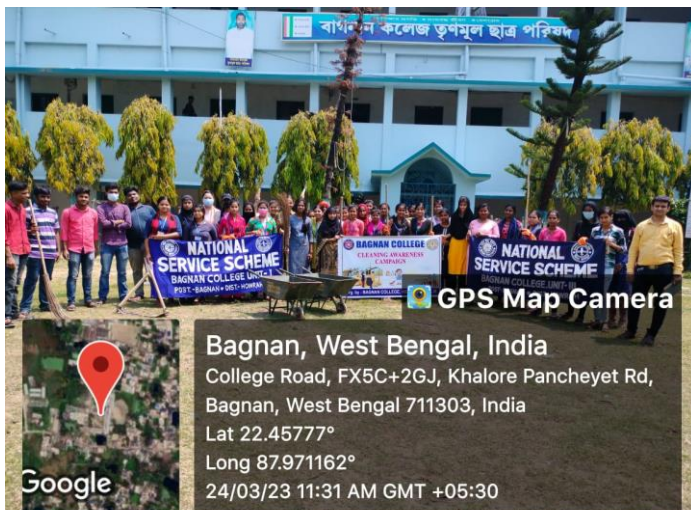

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME AT KHALORE RURAL VILLAGE MARKET AND SURROUNDING AREAS

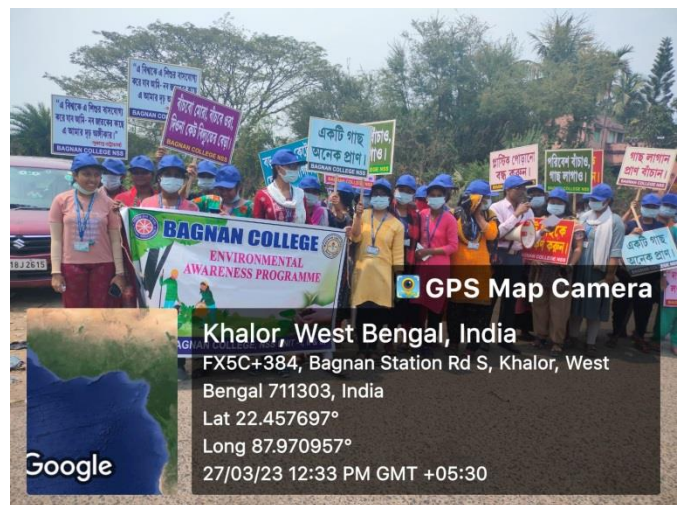

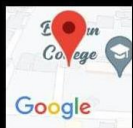

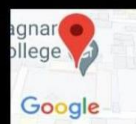
